We aim to -

1. Carbon Footprint Assessment

Enhance our waste management practices by prioritising waste reduction, recycling and responsible disposal including zero waste to landfill. Minimising the use of printed materials and increasing the use of recycled paper and electronic processes.

5. Employee Engagement

Educate and engage our employees in sustainability practices to foster a culture of environmental responsibility. Implement training initiatives to raise awareness amongst our staff about energy conservation, waste reduction and the importance of sustainable practices in our industry.

6. Supply Chain Sustainability

We are proud to have achieved Silver standard with Supply Chain Sustainability School. Launched in 2012, the School Chain Sustainability School (SCSS) is a multi-award winning initiative which represents a common approach to addressing sustainability within our supply chains. We will continue to collaborate with our suppliers to prioritise sustainable sourcing and reduce the environmental impact of the products and materials used in the course of our business activities. We will seek partnerships with suppliers and subcontractors who share our commitment to environmental responsibility.
